

4. Read Ephesians 6:10-18 carefully. What are the actions Paul calls us to take in battling the spiritual forces of evil?

Ephesians 6: ¹⁰ Finally, be strong in the Lord and in the strength of his might. ¹¹ Put on the whole armor of God, that you may be able to stand against the schemes of the devil. ¹² For we do not wrestle against flesh and blood, but against the rulers, against the authorities, against the cosmic powers over this present darkness, against the spiritual forces of evil in the heavenly places. ¹³ Therefore take up the whole armor of God, that you may be able to withstand in the evil day, and having done all, to stand firm. ¹⁴ Stand therefore, having fastened on the belt of truth, and having put on the breastplate of righteousness, ¹⁵ and, as shoes for your feet, having put on the readiness given by the gospel of peace. ¹⁶ In all circumstances take up the shield of faith, with which you can extinguish all the flaming darts of the evil one; ¹⁷ and take the helmet of salvation, and the sword of the Spirit, which is the word of God, ¹⁸ praying at all times in the Spirit, with all prayer and supplication. To that end, keep alert with all perseverance, making supplication for all the saints...

Genesis 1:1

We are _____ beings and God is the supreme spiritual being.

The Unseen Realm

The _____ word of the first sentence on the first page is Elohim (אֱלֹהִים).

Elohim is similar to our English word “God” in that it can refer to God (capital G) and to a god or gods (lower case g). But it’s also very different. It can simply mean “spiritual _____” or refer to an “inhabitant of the spiritual realm.”

Elohim (who is Yahweh) _____ other elohim, other “spiritual beings” that inhabit the spiritual realm.

BibleProject “Elohim” Video:

“God (Elohim) alone is God (Elohim, the supreme Spiritual Being, Yahweh) and he is above all other spiritual beings (elohim). There is only one Elohim (the supreme Spiritual Being who is Creator, Yahweh).”

1 Corinthians 8: ⁴ Therefore, as to the eating of food offered to idols, we know that “an idol has no real existence,” and that “there is no God but one.” ⁵ For although there may be so-called gods in heaven or on earth—as indeed there are many “gods” and many “lords”—⁶ yet for us there is one God, the Father, from whom are all things and for whom we exist, and one Lord, Jesus Christ, through whom are all things and through whom we exist.

1 Corinthians 10: ¹⁹ What do I imply then? That food offered to idols is anything, or that an idol is anything? ²⁰ No, I imply that what pagans sacrifice they offer to demons and not to God. I do not want you to be participants with demons.

Deuteronomy 32: ¹⁷ They sacrificed to demons [“demons” are elohim (as a category title)] who were not God [Eloah], to gods [elohim] whom they have not known...
