4.	The biblical vision of the new creation is that we will not only be restored spiritually and physically, but we will also be restored to our role as rulers (on God's behalf) over creation. Read the passage below (including Genesis 1:26-28 in the sermon outline) and then consider how we can begin now to live out this future role (doing God's will on earth as it is in heaven). Matthew 5: ⁵ Blessed are the meek, for they will inherit the earth. Matthew 25: ³⁴ "Then the King will say to those on his right, 'Come, you who are blessed by my Father; take your inheritance, the kingdom prepared for you since the creation of the world. 1 Corinthians 6: ¹ If any of you has a dispute with another, do you dare to take it before the ungodly for judgment instead of before the Lord's people? ³ Do you not know that we will judge angels?
